What is the Autism Assessment Hub?

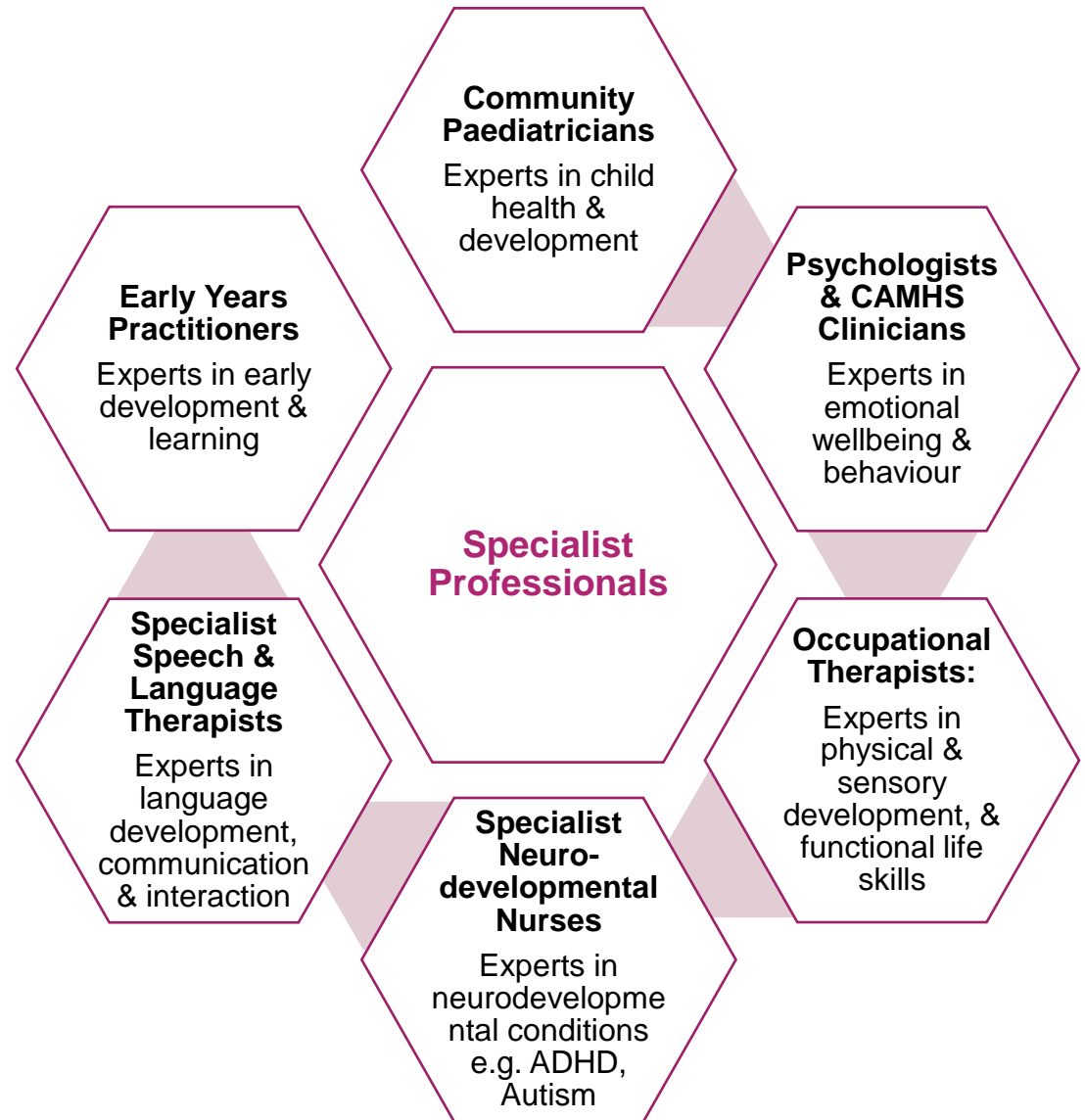
The Autism Assessment Hub coordinates the assessment and diagnosis for children and young people (**up to the age of 18**), who are registered with a GP in **Bristol and South Gloucestershire**, who are experiencing **difficulties and differences that are associated with Autism**.

The Hub is in South Bristol – please our website for contact details. Some assessments will happen at the hub, and some will happen in other settings.

Appointment invitations will include more information about how to get to the Hub, including public transport details. You can read about the assessment types we offer on our website.

Who works at the Autism Assessment Hub?

A group of specialist health professionals work together at the Hub. Working together in the same space means that the team can carry out faster, joined up assessments and the family shouldn't have to repeat the same things to lots of different people. A child or young person will be assessed by at least two professionals from the groups opposite, depending on their needs.
